**Dear Mr. Shropshire:**

On October 23, 2007, the Federal Election Commission ("FEC" or "Commission") notified 10<sup>th</sup> and McKenzie Ltd. Partnership of a complaint alleging certain violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. A copy of the complaint was enclosed with the notification.

After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission has determined to exercise its prosecutorial discretion and take no further action against the Respondents 10<sup>th</sup> and McKenzie Ltd. Partnership. In its memorandum to the Commission, dated February 13, 2008, this office stated:

The FECA prohibits foreign nationals from making contributions, donations, expenditures, independent expenditures or disbursements, directly or indirectly, in connection with a Federal, State, or local election. The Complainant alleges that candidates for local office in the Bellingham, Washington vicinity accepted contributions from foreign nationals.

Specifically, the complaint alleges that Pike for Mayor (Pike), advocating the election of Daniel Pike as Mayor of Bellingham, Washington, accepted a contribution in the amount of \$500 from the 10<sup>th</sup> and McKenzie Ltd. Partnership (McKenzie) on September 26, 2007. The complaint asserts that McKenzie is a Canadian partnership.

Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on November 6, 2008.

The FEC is obligated by federal regulations to make a finding to terminate its proceedings public, as well as the basis therefore. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b). In addition, the Commission will also place on the record copies of the complaint, correspondence exchanged between Respondent(s) and the Commission, and reports prepared for the


