Dear Ms. Fraser:

This letter responds to your notification on behalf of our clients, Schock for Congress and Rachel Honegger, as treasurer (collectively "Campaign"), that the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") assigned the above-referenced matter to your office for processing. On August 11, 2008, you sent me a letter requesting a response to the original notification in the matter and any information that we wish to provide to your office. The information we wish to provide is listed below.

In the Summer of 2007, the Campaign hired Chris Ward to serve as its treasurer and provide compliance services. Specifically, Mr. Ward assisted the Campaign with completing its Commission reports and filings, reconciled its bank accounts, and provided compliance advice. However, he did not have access to the Campaign's bank accounts or authority to make expenditures.

In January 2008, the allegations concerning Chris Ward became public through press reports. After the allegations were made public, the Campaign was unable to communicate with Mr. Ward and terminated his relationship with the Campaign. The Campaign named a new treasurer and began a review of its recent financial records and Commission reports and filings. The internal review of the report at issue in this matter was completed in March 2008. This review revealed that the Campaign's 2008 12-Day Pre-Primary Report did not include approximately \$57,567 in expenditures. On March 24, 2008, the Campaign, on its own volition, filed an amended report containing the previously undisclosed expenditures.



The Campaign has taken steps to ensure that the type of mistake at issue in this matter does not happen again in the future. First, the Campaign terminated its relationship with Mr. Ward and he no longer serves as treasurer. Second, the Campaign retained the services of another campaign compliance individual who has many years experience with the reporting obligations of federal campaign committees. Third, the Campaign is in the process of conducting an internal review of its financial records and Commission reports and filings. Even though the review is not yet complete, the Campaign has already taken immediate action to correct the public record by filing the amended report at issue in this matter. The filing of the amended report constitutes timely disclosure by the Campaign to the Commission of the issues involved in this matter.

We will contact you in the near future to schedule a meeting so that we can discuss this matter and how to proceed.
