Treasurer, Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 09L-14 for processing, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 492. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 492 on May 4, 2009. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions or concerns before then. A copy of the referral is in the voting ballots folder.

Summary of Case: RAD referred the Committee to Re-Elect Ed Towns and Albert C. Wiltshire, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report. Respondents filed their original 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report on August 28, 2008. On December 4, 2008, the Committee filed an amended 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report that disclosed additional receipts totaling \$111,705.03. In response to an inquiry from RAD, Respondents stated that bank deposit slips were not recorded in an internal ledger by an assistant, and thus the Treasurer was not aware of the receipts at the time the original 2008 12 Day Pre-Primary Report was filed.
