
Dear Ms. Ledoux:

The Federal Election Commission (FEC/Commission) determined on November 17, 2009 to exercise its prosecutorial discretion regarding ADR 507 (RAD 09L-29) and close the file. Attached is a copy of the certification of that vote.

The FEC is obligated by federal regulations to make a finding to terminate its proceedings public, as well as the basis therefore. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b).
