SUBJECT: ADR 524 New York Republican Federal Campaign Committee and Jane Corwin, Treasurer, Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division referred RAD 09L-42 for processing on November 16, 2009, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 524. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 524 on November 27, 2009. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: The Reports Analysis Division referred the New York Republican Federal Campaign Committee and Jane Corwin, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for a series of reporting errors and other FECA violations during the 2008 election cycle. A political committee may be referred if, after an internal review of reports filed by the committee, the Commission determines the reports do not meet the threshold requirements for substantial compliance with the FECA. The Committee's errors included, among other things: mathematical discrepancies, a failure to provide supporting schedules, a failure to properly itemize contributions and disbursements, Federal Election Activity, and the allocation of Federal and Non-federal activity.
