
Dear Ms. Morse:

A letter was sent to your office on November 27, 2009, regarding an opportunity to participate in the Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") program at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC/Commission") to resolve a referral from the Reports Analysis Division. The referral was for possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act by Washington State Republican Party and Colleen Morse, Treasurer ("Respondents"). The Commission received no reply from Respondents.

If Respondents are interested in having this referral resolved through ADR, you must affirmatively respond **no later than January 15, 2010**, by filing an executed Commitment to Submit Matter to ADR Program, with or without a Statement of Designation of Representative/Counsel. Another copy of this document is enclosed for your convenience. In the event you submit these documents via facsimile (202-219-0613), please send the originals via first class mail to this Office.

A lack of response will be considered a disinterest in proceeding in ADR and will result in the matter regarding your Committee being forwarded to the FEC's Office of General Counsel for appropriate enforcement action.
