Recommendation to Approve Negotiated Settlement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Attend a FEC conference; develop and implement a compliance manual; and pay a civil penalty of \$5,000.

Attached for your review is a signed ADR Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 551 (RAD 10L-11). The ADR Office received this referral on October 28, 2010.

**SUMMARY:** RAD referred Segall for Congress and Charles McDowell Crook, Jr., Treasurer, (Respondents or the Committee) for failure to refund or redesignate 2010 General Election contributions totaling \$50,750.00 within the permissible timeframe following the candidate's withdrawal from the primary election. Respondents acknowledge that the appropriate refunds were not made within the sixty day timeframe and contend they were unaware of the timeframe required to make the refunds. Respondents have subsequently refunded all general election contributions.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

1. Approve the attached Negotiated Settlement of Segall for Congress and C. McDowell Crook, Jr., Treasurer.
2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
