Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") referred Westmoreland for Congress and Ann B. Hand, Treasurer, ("Respondents") for processing on December 9, 2010, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 555. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents on December 17, 2010. Please contact Krista Roche if you have any questions or concerns before that date.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Respondents for failing to disclose all financial activity on their election sensitive 2010 12 Day Pre-Primary Report, originally filed on July 8, 2010. On September 16, 2010, the Committee filed an amended 2010 12 Day Pre-Primary Report disclosing additional disbursements of \$88,000.00, a 63.7% increase over the originally reported activity. To explain the discrepancy, the Committee responded to a Request for Additional Information from RAD by filing a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission which stated that the "original report was unfortunately incomplete."
