SUBJECT: ADR 556 Congressional Black Caucus PAC and Earl Jenkins, Treasurer, Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 10L-15 for processing on December 13, 2010, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 556. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 556 on December 20, 2010. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: RAD referred the Congressional Black Caucus PAC and Earl Jenkins, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2009 Year End Report, as well as their 2010 April Quarterly Report. The Committee filed its original 2009 Year End Report on January 29, 2010. An amended 2009 Year End Report was filed on May 14, 2010 that disclosed additional receipts of \$142,087.64 and additional disbursements of \$135,616.50. Respondents filed an original 2010 April Quarterly Report on April 15, 2010, and an amended 2010 April Quarterly Report on May 14, 2010 that disclosed additional receipts of \$115,000.

In response to an inquiry from RAD about the increase in financial activity, Respondents stated that the information was not accessible at the time the reports were due to be filed.
