Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 11L-03 for processing on February 11, 2011, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 560. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 560 on February 18, 2011. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Bob Turner for Congress and Kevin Turner, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2010 12 Day Pre-Primary Report. Specifically, the Committee filed its original 2010 12 Day Pre-Primary Report on September 2, 2010. On October 13, 2010, the Committee filed the first Amended 2010 12 Day Pre-Primary Report and on January 13, 2011 it filed a second Amended 2010 12 Day Pre-Primary Report. The two Amended 2010 12 Day Pre-Primary Reports disclosed additional receipts totaling \$105,166.82 and additional disbursements totaling \$141,575.10.

Respondents contend the omitted data was due to computer and software issues, which they took steps to correct after speaking with RAD and the Electronic Filing Office.
