FEC Violations by Candidate Joseph W. Miller

This complaint is based on my personal knowledge after reading the FEC filings by candidate for US Senate in Alaska Joseph W. Miller. In his July, 2010 FEC filing, Candidate Joseph W. Miller lists fuel reimbursement for campaign flights on a private plane owned by Fairbanks attorney Thomas Wickwire. That report also lists Wickwire's fuel expense as an in-kind contribution. Whether they are campaign expenses or in-kind contributions, they are violations of FEC regulations that require a candidate for US Senate flying on a private aircraft to pay the charter rate for a comparable plane. Mr. Miller's campaign also violated the FEC regulation that requires the charter rate for these flights to be paid within seven days of the flight.

Miller's July FEC filing (page 41 of 98) lists an in-kind, \$900 contribution from Wickwire for aviation fuel expenses for trips on June 12 & 22 with no destinations listed. However the same report lists campaign disbursements of \$900 for aviation fuel for the same two trips (page 88 of 98). It also lists a payment to Thomas Wickwire of \$550 for a June 17 trip from Fairbanks to Bethel (page 89 of 98). These dates may not be accurate for the campaign trips taken since Miller's campaign events calendar lists trips to Kenai, Alaska on June 18<sup>th</sup>, Bethel, Alaska on June 22<sup>nd</sup> and Barrow on June 24<sup>th</sup>.

As shown on his campaign events calendar, after the July FEC filing, Mr. Miller flew to Valdez, Cordova, Glenallen, Tok and Delta Junction, Alaska on one day-July 20<sup>th</sup> and to Nome, Alaska on August 4<sup>th</sup> on a private plane. This plane may have been Mr. Wickwire's or another private plane but Mr. Miller's FEC filing for this time period show no expenditure's for aviation fuel and these trips with extended stays on the ground for campaign events would not have been possible in one day flying on commercial airplanes.

Attached is Mr. Wickwire's FAA registration. A conservative charter rate for these types of aircraft in Alaska is \$300/hour for flight and standby time plus fuel purchased at charter stops. Each of these flights could have cost more than the \$2,400 individual contribution limit for a US Senate campaign. So, if they were to be treated as in-kind contributions, the airplane's owner may be in violation of FEC regulations.

**Section of the Honest Leadership and Open Government Act of 2007 (HLOGA)  
Regarding Use of Non-Commercial Aircraft by Candidates for Federal Office**

**TITLE VI--PROHIBITED USE OF PRIVATE AIRCRAFT**

**SEC. 601. RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF CAMPAIGN FUNDS FOR FLIGHTS ON  
NONCOMMERCIAL AIRCRAFT.**

(a) Restrictions- Section 313 of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 439a) is amended by adding at the end the following new subsection:

(c) ~~Restrictions on Use of Campaign Funds for Flights on Noncommercial Aircraft~~

(1) ~~IN GENERAL- Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, a candidate for election for Federal office (other than a candidate who is subject to paragraph (2)), or any authorized committee of such a candidate, may not make any expenditure for a flight on an aircraft unless:~~

(A) the aircraft is operated by an air carrier or commercial operator certificated by the Federal Aviation Administration and the flight is required to be conducted under air carrier safety rules, or, in the case of travel which is abroad, by an air carrier or commercial operator certificated by an appropriate foreign civil aviation authority and the flight is required to be conducted under air carrier safety rules; or

(B) the candidate, the authorized committee, or other political committee pays to the owner, lessee, or other person who provides the aircraft the pro rata share of the fair market value of such flight (as determined by dividing the fair market value of the normal and usual charter fare or rental charge for a comparable plane of comparable size by the number of candidates on the flight) within a commercially reasonable time frame after the date on which the flight is taken.

(2) ~~HOUSE CANDIDATES- Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, in the case of a candidate for election for the office of Representative in, or Delegate or Resident Commissioner to, the Congress, an authorized committee and a leadership PAC of the candidate may not make any expenditure for a flight on an aircraft unless--~~

(A) the aircraft is operated by an air carrier or commercial operator certificated by the Federal Aviation Administration and the flight is required to be conducted under air carrier safety rules, or, in the case of travel which is abroad, by an air carrier or commercial operator certificated by an appropriate foreign civil aviation authority and the flight is required to be conducted under air carrier safety rules; or

(B) the aircraft is operated by an entity of the Federal government or the government of any State.

~~(3) EXCEPTION FOR AIRCRAFT OWNED OR LEASED BY CANDIDATE-~~

(A) ~~IN GENERAL- Paragraphs (1) and (2) do not apply to a flight on an aircraft owned or leased by the candidate involved or an immediate family member of the candidate (including an aircraft owned by an entity that is not a public corporation in which the candidate or an immediate family member of the candidate has an ownership interest), so long as the candidate does not use the aircraft more than the candidate's or immediate family member's proportionate share of ownership allows.~~

(B) ~~IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER DEFINED- In this subparagraph (A), the term 'immediate family member' means, with respect to a candidate, a father, mother, son, daughter, brother, sister, husband, wife, father-in-law, or mother-in-law.~~

Regulations published in the **Federal Register**, Vol. 74, No. 233, 63951-63968 and effective January 6, 2010 implemented the federal statute on use of a private plane in a federal campaign. An explanation of those regulations, 11 CFR parts 100, 113 and 9034 appeared in the "Federal Election Commission RECORD" (FEC RECORD), Volume 36 Number 10, October 2010. The explanation about campaign travel by a US Senate candidate on a private aircraft appears is on page 6 of the FEC RECORD and states:

**"Presidential, Vice-Presidential and Senate Candidate Travel**

New 11 CFR 100.93(c)(1) requires candidates for President, Vice-President and the U.S. Senate to pay the pro rata share of the fair market value of non-commercial flights. The pro rata share is determined by dividing the fair market value of the normal and usual charter fare or rental charge for a comparable aircraft of comparable size by the number of campaign travelers flying on behalf of each candidate on the flight. The term "comparable aircraft" means an aircraft of similar make and model as the aircraft that actually makes the trip, with similar amenities as that aircraft. The Commission's new regulations interpret HLOGA to include helicopters when determining "comparable aircraft." 11 CFR 100.93(a)(3)(vi).

The pro rata share is calculated based on the number of candidates represented on a flight, regardless of whether the individual candidate is actually present on the flight. A candidate is represented on a flight if a person is traveling on behalf of that candidate or the candidate's authorized committee...~~The reimbursement must be made to the service provider within seven calendar days after the date the flight began to avoid the receipt of an in-kind contribution.~~

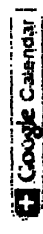

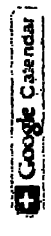
