The Audit Division (Audit) referred AD 09-29 for processing on April 13, 2011, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 566. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 566 on April 20, 2011. Summary of Case: Audit referred the OPEIU JB Moss Voice of the Electorate (formerly known as the Office and Professional Employees International Union – Voice of the Electorate) and Mary Mahoney, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for underreporting disbursements by \$171,938 during calendar years 2007-2008. Audit determined that a major portion of the underreporting occurred during the Committee's Post-General reporting period for 2008. In addition, Respondents discovered the problem, and on their own initiative, filed amended reports which materially corrected the underreporting.
