- V. BACKGROUND:

The Committee is the principal campaign committee for Roscoe Bartlett, a candidate in the 2010 election for Maryland's 6th Congressional District. The candidate won the November 2, 2010 General Election with 61.5% of the vote.

The Committee was sent seventeen (17) Requests for Additional Information (RFAs) for reporting errors involving excessive and/or prohibited contributions, mathematical discrepancies, missing schedules, and inadequate contributor information.
