The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 11L-11 for processing on April 29, 2011, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 571. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents on May 9, 2011. Please contact Krista Roche if you have any questions or concerns before that date.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Bartlett for Congress Committee and Robert Perry, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for a series of reporting errors and other FECA violations during the 2009-2010 election cycle. A political committee may be referred if, after an internal review of reports filed by the committee, the Commission determines the reports do not meet the threshold requirements for substantial compliance with the FECA. The Committee's errors included, among other items: excessive and/or prohibited contributions, mathematical discrepancies, missing schedules, and inadequate contributor information.
