The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 11L-21 on August 17, 2011, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 587. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 587 on August 31, 2011. Please contact Krista Roche if you have any questions, comments or concerns before then.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred National Emergency Medicine Political Action Committee and Phyllis Edans, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to file one 48-Hour Notice totaling \$40,000 to support one independent expenditure disclosed on the 2010 12-Day Pre-General Report.

Respondents contend that the new staff member who filed the 12-Day Pre-General Report was unaware of the requirement to file a separate 48-Hour Notice and that the Committee provided additional training to this staff person to prevent an error of this type in the future.
