Dear Mr. Nason:

On July 22, 2011, the Federal Election Commission (FEC/Commission) received your complaint alleging certain violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission failed on a vote of 3 to 3 to approve the settlement agreement, and thus will take no action against the Respondents Committee to Re-Elect Gary Jensen, Mayor of Ferndale and Fleetwood International Development Corporation. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on January 24, 2012. Attached please find a copy of the certification of the final vote.

The FEC is obligated by federal regulations to make a finding to terminate its proceedings public, as well as the basis therefore. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b). In addition, the Commission will also place on the record certain documents, such as the copy of the complaint, and correspondence exchanged between Respondents and the Commission. As well as the certification of the final vote. Accordingly, copies of relevant documents will be forwarded shortly to the FEC's Public Information Office.

The Act allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action. See 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(8).
