The Federal Election Commission (FEC/Commission) failed on a vote of 3 to 3 to approve the settlement agreement regarding ADR 592 (MUR 6490). Thus, the Commission will take no further action against Respondents. Attached is a copy of the certification of that vote on January 24, 2012.

The FEC is obligated by federal regulations to make a finding to terminate its proceedings public, as well as the basis therefore. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b). In addition, as of January 1, 2004, the Commission will also place on the record copies of the complaint, correspondence exchanged between Respondents and this office, and the certification of the vote. Accordingly, copies of documents relative to this matter will be forwarded shortly to the FEC's Public Information Office.

This concludes the matter brought to the attention of the FEC by Kristain Nason, Campaign Manager for Vote Norbert, regarding an alleged violation of the federal election campaign laws.
