Informational Memo on Assignment

The ADR Office received the referral of RAD 11L-26 from the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) on October 14, 2011, and designated the referral as ADR 595. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 595 on October 25, 2011. Please contact Krista Roche if you have any questions, comments or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: RAD referred the Bob Goodlatte for Congress Committee and Kenneth Lorenz Prickitt, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity. On April 15, 2011, the Committee filed its original 2011 April Quarterly Report. On May 4, 2011, the Committee filed an Amended 2011 April Quarterly Report disclosing \$126,977.75 in additional receipts. The Committee contends, in a Form 99 response to a Request for Additional Information, that the error is the result of a software malfunction which occurred during the upload of the data.
