Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 12L-11 on March 13, 2012, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 610. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 610 on March 23, 2012. **Summary of Case:** RAD referred Mulvaney for Congress and Patricia J. Jenkins, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2010 October Quarterly and 2010 30 Day Post-General Reports. The Committee amended its 2010 October Quarterly and 2010 30 Day Post-General Reports to disclose additional receipts of \$65,346.30 and additional disbursements of \$2,157.72 for an aggregate of undisclosed activity of \$67,504.02.

Respondents filed two electronic Form 99s stating that following additional reviews of financial activity disclosed in reports filed with the Commission, that amended reports were required to correct the record.
