The Federal Election Commission (FEC/Commission) failed on a vote of 3 to 3 to approve the settlement agreement regarding ADR 610 (RAD 12L-11). Thus, the Commission will take no further action against Respondents. Attached is a copy of the certification of that vote on December 18, 2012.

The FEC is obligated by federal regulations to make a finding to terminate its proceedings public, as well as the basis therefore. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b).
