The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 13L-10 on April 26, 2013, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 636. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 636 on May 3, 2013. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions, comments or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: RAD referred the Mason Tenders District Council of Greater New York and LI PAC and Victor Rizzo, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2012 April Quarterly Report. Specifically, the Committee filed an amended 2012 April Quarterly Report in July 2012 that disclosed an additional \$130,466.95 in receipts.

Respondents contend that the need for an amended disclosure resulted from an inadvertent failure to include all March receipts. The Committee stated that the increase in receipts from those reported initially on the 2012 April Quarterly Report resulted from an unexpected delay in the transmission of contributions from its collecting agent.

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
