SUBJECT: ADR 637 WOMEN VOTE! and Stephanie Schriock, Treasurer, Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Send a representative to an FEC seminar and pay a civil penalty of \$1,800.

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 637 (RAD 13L-14). The ADR Office received this referral on May 16, 2013.

SUMMARY: RAD referred WOMEN VOTE! and Stephanie Schriock, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial information. On November 5, 2012, the Committee filed an amended 2012 12 Day Pre-General Report disclosing an additional \$169,097.04 in debts.

In response to a Request for Additional Information, the Committee contends that WOMEN VOTE! promptly amended the report once the independent expenditures at issue were discovered, making sure to disclose all information prior to the election. Further, the Committee contends that it has reviewed internal procedures and made comprehensive changes to ensure that reports are properly filed in the future.
