The Federal Election Commission (FEC/Commission) determined on December 17, 2013 to exercise its prosecutorial discretion regarding ADR 640 (MUR 6700) and close the file. Attached is a copy of the certification of that vote.

The FEC is obligated by federal regulations to make a finding to terminate its proceedings public, as well as the basis therefore. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b). In addition, as of January 1, 2004, the Commission will also place on the record copies of the complaint, correspondence exchanged between Respondent(s) and this office, and reports prepared for the Commission by this office to assist in its consideration of this matter.
