A letter was sent to your office on June 17, 2013, regarding an opportunity to participate in the Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") program at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC/Commission") to resolve a referral from the Reports Analysis Division. A lack of response will be considered a disinterest in proceeding in ADR and will result in the matter regarding your Committee being forwarded to the FEC's Office of General Counsel.
