SUBJECT: ADR 652 Liberty Unleashed and Jae Kim, Treasurer,
Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Work with Commission staff to terminate the Committee; and pay
a civil penalty of \$1,000.

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 652 (RAD 13L-30). The ADR Office received this referral on July 29, 2013.

SUMMARY: In this case, the Reports Analysis Division referred Liberty Unleashed and Jae Kim, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2012 October Quarterly Report. The Committee filed an amended 2012 October Quarterly Report on February 22, 2013 that disclosed additional receipts of \$80,054.19.

Respondents acknowledge an inadvertent error of uploading the wrong file by the all volunteer and inexperienced group. The Committee uploaded the incorrect file for the original report which reflected no record of any contributions received. As soon as Respondents realized the omission, the Committee filed an amended 2012 October Quarterly Report to correct the record. Respondents contend they were comprised of volunteers who wished to host a single event, and that they made changes to ensure correct reporting.
