Treasurer, Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Terminate reporting obligations.

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 653 (RAD 13L-32). The ADR Office received this referral on August 6, 2013.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division referred Respondents for failing to disclose all financial activity on the 2012 July Quarterly Report. The Committee filed an amendment to that report to disclose additional disbursements totaling \$205,953.05 for the partial repayment of a candidate loan.

Respondents contend that not including disbursement on the initially-filed report was an inadvertent clerical error which was remedied promptly after discovery; the public record is now accurate and the relevant report was properly amended. Respondents further contend that the Committee was a new, volunteer organization who found the software difficult to use.
