Treasurer, Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 12L-45 on October 29, 2013, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 664. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 664 on November 6, 2013. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions, comments or concerns before then.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred the North Carolina Republican Party and Jeffrey A. Morse, Jr., Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2012 30 Day Post-General Report. On April 30, 2013, the Committee filed an Amended 2012 30 Day Post-General Report that disclosed additional receipts totaling \$172,521.14.

Respondents, in an electronic response to the Request for Additional Information stated that the Amended 2012 30 Day Post-General Report included three in-kind transfers from the Republican National Committee that were inadvertently omitted from the original report.
