SUBJECT: ADR 704 Campaign For Working Families and Dorie Velezis,  
Treasurer, Informational Memo on Assignment

The Office of General Counsel referred RR 13L-43 on March 10, 2014, and the ADR Office designated the referral as ADR 704. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 704 on March 14, 2014. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions or concerns before then.

**Summary of Case:** The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred the Campaign For Working Families and Dorie Velezis, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to file one (1) 48-Hour Report to support two (2) independent expenditures totaling \$124,037.17 disclosed on the 2012 12 Day Pre-General Report. In addition, the Committee failed to timely file one (1) 24-Hour Report totaling \$27,500 to support one (1) independent expenditure disclosed on the 2012 30 Day Post-General Report.

Respondents contend that the late reporting of the three independent expenditures was the result of inadvertent technical or administrative errors. Respondents further contend that as the independent expenditures were disclosed on other reports the impact on the public was minimal.
