SUBJECT: ADR 711 Republican National Committee and Anthony W. Parker, Treasurer, Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Develop and certify the distribution of procedures to vendors for the identification and reporting of debts and obligations; and pay a civil penalty of \$3,400.

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to **ADR 711 (RAD 14L-10)**. The ADR Office received this referral on April 2, 2014.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division referred Republican National Committee and Anthony W. Parker, Treasurer, (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on their 2013 February Monthly Report originally filed on February 20, 2013. On June 21, 2013, the committee filed an Amended 2013 February Monthly Report disclosing \$106,793.60 in additional debts.

On October 7, 2013, the Committee filed a Miscellaneous Electronic Statement (Form 99) which stated that the original report was filed using best efforts to obtain all required information. In this Form 99 the Committee contended that the report was amended promptly upon the discovery of

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
