On March 3, 2014 I wrote a check returning the money back to Temperature Control Systems, Inc. I was unaware of wrong doing as I clearly put this contribution on my filing. This money was never spent by the campaign.


2. Walter Parker is accused of giving me \$5,000, and that was a mistake on my part. It was a joint contribution from Walter Parker and his wife Ella Parker. I did not fill out the form correctly, and I have amended that form already after seeking advice from the FEC on how to correct that error. I now know how to properly complete the form.

3. This addresses my Form 2. I did complete and send one in. I am unsure why it is not on file, but I have resent it to the FEC.

I am not sure what else you, or the FEC might want to receive from me, but when I spoke with Kim Collins she stated that you wanted a statement. Being a first time candidate I made some rookie mistakes, but I feel like after learning of these errors I corrected them quickly.

I affirm that I, John William Stacy, am making this statement under oath to tell the entire truth, under penalty of perjury, that this statement is accurate.
