SUMMARY: In this case, Complainant Louis P. Gigliotti alleged that John Stacy, John Stacy for U.S. Congress and Ella Parker, Treasurer (the Committee) accepted a prohibited corporate contribution from Respondent Temperature Control Systems, Inc. (Respondent TCS) in the amount of \$5,000. In addition, the complaint alleges that the Committee accepted an excessive contribution in the amount of \$5,000 from Walter Parker and that Respondent Stacy failed to submit a Statement of Candidacy (FEC Form 2).

The Committee contends that the contribution in the amount of \$5,000 was not excessive, but rather an incorrectly attributed joint contribution by Walter and Ella Parker. A revised report was filed to correctly disclose the joint contribution and correct the record. The Committee further contends that due to inexperience, it accepted the prohibited contribution from Respondent TCS. The contribution was refunded to Respondent TCS on March 3, 2014 and the record corrected. In addition, Respondent Stacy contends that he submitted the Statement of Candidacy (FEC Form 2), to the Commission on November 1, 2013, and does not know why the Commission did not receive it. The Statement of Candidacy was resubmitted and received by the Commission on March 13, 2014.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the attached settlement agreement of John Stacy, John Stacy for U.S. Congress and Ella Parker, Treasurer, and Temperature Control Systems, Inc.
2. Dismiss the complaint as it pertains to John Stacy in his individual capacity.
3. Dismiss the complaint as it pertains to Walter Parker.
4. Approve the appropriate letters.
5. Close the file on this matter.
