The Federal Election Commission (FEC/Commission) determined on December 9, 2014 to exercise its prosecutorial discretion regarding ADR 724 (P-MUR 531) and close the file. Attached is a copy of the certification of that vote.

The FEC is obligated by federal regulations to make a finding to terminate its proceedings public, as well as the basis therefore. 11 C.F.R. § 111.20(b). In addition, as of January 1, 2004, the Commission will also place on the record copies of the complaint, and correspondence exchanged between Respondents and this office. Accordingly, copies of documents relative to this matter will be forwarded shortly to the FEC's Public Information Office.

This concludes the matter brought to the attention of the FEC by the International Association of Heat and Frost Insulators and Allied Workers Political Action Committee regarding a violation of the federal election campaign laws.
