Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 14L-27 for processing on August 5, 2014, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 732. We included a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We anticipate initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 732 on August 15, 2014. Please contact Lynn Fraser if you have any questions or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Friends of John Boehner and Lisa Lisker, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to remedy excessive 2012 Primary and General Election contributions timely. The Committee received excessive contributions totaling \$57,276 for the 2012 elections from thirty-two (32) individuals, four (4) multicandidate political actions committees, and three (3) non-multicandidate political action committees. The Committee did not timely refund, reattribute or redesignate these contributions.

Respondents contend, in several Miscellaneous Text messages (Form 99) filed in response to RFAs concerning the possible excessive contributions, outlining the corrective action taken regarding the apparent excessive contributions.
