Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 759 (RAD 15L-15). The ADR Office received this referral on May 5, 2015.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred All Citizens for Mississippi and Jacqueline Vann, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely file four (4) 24-Hour Reports totaling \$26,775.71 to support five (5) independent expenditures disclosed on the 2014 July Quarterly Report.

On January 12, 2015, the Committee filed a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission (Form 99) in response to a Request for Additional Information and explained that

that the errors occurred due to the inexperience of the person preparing the report and a lack of an understanding of the filing requirements.
