
Dear Mr. Roberson and Ms. Sund:

A letter was sent on November 3, 2015, regarding an opportunity to participate in the Alternative Dispute Resolution ("ADR") program at the Federal Election Commission ("FEC/Commission") to resolve a complaint filed by Nicholas A. Passanante. The complaint alleged possible violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act by Sharon Sund for Congress and Eugene Roberson, Treasurer, ("Respondents"). The Commission received no reply from Respondents.
