**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME FOR ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS
AND TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

Respondent, The Home Depot Inc. Political Action Committee and Scott Bohrer in his official capacity as treasurer ("Home Depot PAC"), filed a *sua sponte* submission with the Federal Election Commission (the "Commission") on February 11, 2016. Home Depot PAC hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for the Commission's internal enforcement proceedings and any civil enforcement action that the Commission might institute against it in connection with this matter, pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6), for a period of 120 calendar days.

This agreement will toll the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time for the Commission to institute a civil law enforcement suit, or take any other enforcement action, without the written consent of Home Depot PAC or its counsel.
