The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 17L-06 for processing on February 14, 2017, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 820. Summary of Case: RAD referred the Working Families Party Independent Expenditure Committee and Mike Boland, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to file one (1) 24-Hour Report to support one (1) independent expenditure totaling \$44,619.51. This expenditure was disclosed on the 2016 July Quarterly Report made after the 20th day but more than 24 hours before the 2016 Primary Election held in the state of Oregon on May 17, 2016.

The Committee filed one (1) 24-Hour Report on December 14, 2016 to support one (1) independent expenditure, totaling \$44,619.51, disseminated on May 3, 2016.
