Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Certify that a representative of the Committee participated
in an FEC conference, webinar, or other program
developed in consultation with the FEC's Information
Division; and pay a civil penalty of \$1,500.

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to
ADR 824 (RAD 17L-08). The ADR Office received this referral on April 10, 2017.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division referred the Respondents for failing
to timely file two (2) 48-Hour Reports totaling \$30,140.42 to support twelve (12)
independent expenditures disclosed on the 2016 October Monthly Report.

Respondents filed a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission (FEC Form 99) on
January 14, 2017, stating that the Committee inadvertently and unintentionally
missed two 48-Hour Reports and that steps have been taken to ensure timely
reporting in the future. The expenditures consisted of promotional items, such as
hats and t-shirts, which were distributed exclusively to local union members. All
of the expenditures were disclosed to the public prior to the general election.
Respondents state that it is speculative whether or not, and when, any of the items

were used by local union members or viewed by the general public prior to the election.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the attached settlement agreement of Int'l Union of Bricklayers and Allied Craftworkers PAC and Timothy J. Driscoll, Treasurer.
2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
