



### 2015 July Quarterly Report

During the 2015 July Quarterly reporting period, the Committee received a 2016 General Election contribution in the amount of \$2,700.00 from one (1) individual that was not refunded or redesignated within the permissible timeframe (Attachment 3).

### 2016 April Quarterly Report

During the 2016 April Quarterly reporting period, the Committee received 2016 General Election contributions totaling \$15,000.00 from four (4) individuals and one (1) multicandidate political action committee that were not refunded or redesignated within the permissible timeframe (Attachment 3).

### 2016 12-Day Pre-Primary Report<sup>1</sup>

During the 2016 12-Day Pre-Primary reporting period, the Committee received a 2016 General Election contribution in the amount of \$2,300.00 from one (1) limited liability company that was not refunded or redesignated within the permissible timeframe (Attachment 3).

### 2016 July Quarterly Report

During the 2016 July Quarterly reporting period, the Committee received 2016 General Election contributions totaling \$250.00 from one (1) individual that were not refunded or redesignated within the permissible timeframe (Attachment 3).

On June 28, 2016, the Candidate lost in the Primary Election for New York's 13<sup>th</sup> Congressional District.

On July 11, 2016, Mark Weinstein, the Treasurer of the Committee, contacted the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) Analyst concerning the Committee's reporting. The RAD Analyst advised Mr. Weinstein that since the Candidate will not participate in the 2016 General Election, all General Election contributions must be refunded or redesignated within 60 days of the 2016 Primary Election (Attachment 4).

On September 18, 2016, a Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") referencing the Amended 2016 July Quarterly Report, received July 12, 2016, was sent to the Committee. The RFAI noted the Committee's receipt of 2016 General Election contributions during the 2015-2016 election cycle and requested that the Committee refund or redesignate the contributions since the Candidate was not eligible to participate in the 2016 General Election (Image 201609180300058710).

The public record discloses both "April Quarterly" filings covering 1/1/16 – 3/31/16 and "April Quarterly" filings covering 4/1/16 – 6/8/16, which should have been filed as "12 Day Pre-Primary."

Between October 2016 and January 2017, the RAD Analyst spoke with Mr. Weinstein on multiple occasions concerning the unrefunded 2016 General Election contributions, cited in the September 18, 2016 RFAI, among other items. When Mr. Weinstein expressed his intention to terminate the Committee, the Analyst explained that the matter of unrefunded General Election contributions would be referred to another Commission office, and the Committee would not be eligible for termination while this matter is outstanding (Attachment 4).

To date, no further communications have been received from the Committee regarding this matter.
