SUBJECT: ADR 829 Adam Clayton Powell for Congress and Mark Jay Weinstein, Treasurer, Recommendation to Approve Settlement Agreement

RESOLUTION TERMS: Payment of a civil penalty of \$2,550; file amended reports disclosing any reattributions, redesignations, and refunds; and continue to file disclosure reports until such time as a termination report is approved.

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 829 (RAD 17L-11). The ADR Office received this referral on May 25, 2017.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Respondents for failure to refund, redesignate, or reattribute 2016 General Election contributions totaling \$25,550 within the permissible timeframe following the candidate's loss in the 2016 New York Primary Election.

The Committee contends that it was unaware of the requirement to refund, redesignate, or reattribute general election contributions following the candidate's loss in the primary election. Respondents indicate that \$4,300 of the contributions at issue could have been reattributed to a spouse.
