III. BACKGROUND:

**Failure to Provide Supporting Schedules (Failure to Disclose All Financial Activity)**

CITIZENS UNITED SUPER PAC, LLC ("the Committee") amended its 2016 April Quarterly Report to disclose additional receipts totaling \$115,469.77 that were not disclosed on the original report (Attachment 2).

On April 15, 2016, the Committee filed the 2016 April Quarterly Report covering the period of January 1, 2016 through March 31, 2016. The report disclosed \$11,318.00 in receipts on Line 11(a)(i) (Itemized Individual Contributions), \$94,096.30 on Line 11(a)(ii) (Non-itemized Individual Contributions), and \$0.00 on Line 15 (Offsets to Operating Expenditures) of the Detailed Summary Page (Image 201604159012562763).

On April 29, 2016, the Committee filed an Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The report disclosed \$17,899.00 in receipts on Line 11(a)(i), \$199,985.07 on Line 11(a)(ii), and \$0.00 on Line 15 (Image 201604299015366580).

Subsequently, on April 29, 2016, the Committee filed a second Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The report disclosed \$17,899.00 in receipts on Line 11(a)(i),

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\$199,985.07 on Line 11(a)(ii), and \$3,000.00 on Line 15, a total increase of \$115,469.77 in receipts from the original report (Image 201604299015366830, Attachment 2).

On August 18, 2016, a Request for Additional Information (RAI) was sent to the Committee referencing the Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report, received April 29, 2016. Among other issues, the RAI requested clarification regarding the substantial increase in receipts disclosed on the Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report that were not disclosed in the original filing (Image 201608180300057171).

On September 22, 2016, the Committee filed an Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The report disclosed no change in receipts from the prior amendment (Image 201609229032100365).

Subsequently, on the same day, the Committee submitted a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission ("FEC Form 99") in response to the RAI referencing the Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The FEC Form 99 stated, in part:

"Unfortunately clerical errors made during the data import process resulted in the need to amend our report to disclose the corrected transactions and summary totals. Our amendment was filed shortly after the April Quarterly deadline in order to provide updated information as soon as possible" (Image 201609229032100361).

On October 18, 2016, the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) Analyst called Lauren Catts, the Committee's Treasurer, and informed her that several items from the RAI sent on the Committee's Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report had not been responded to adequately and the issues were on the verge of being sent to another office for potential further action by the Commission. Ms. Catts explained she was simply the signatory for the Committee, and the filings were handled by their attorney, Michael Boos. Ms. Catts transferred the RAD Analyst to Mr. Boos (Attachment 4).

Subsequently, on the same day, the RAD Analyst was transferred to Michael Boos, the Committee's designated agent and attorney. The RAD Analyst explained the Committee had been sent a RAI on their Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report, received April 29, 2016. While noting the Committee had responded to the RAI, the RAD Analyst explained, among other things, that the Committee's explanation for the increase in receipts was inadequate. The RAD Analyst invited the Committee to file additional information regarding this issue, and again explained the apparent violation could be referred on to another office for further action (Attachment 4).

On October 25, 2016 the Committee filed an Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The report disclosed no change in receipts from the prior amendment (Image 201610259034569023).

On November 17, 2016 the Committee filed an Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The report disclosed no change in receipts from the prior amendment (Image 201611179037206606).

On December 16, 2016, the RAD Analyst left a voicemail for Mr. Boos. Among other issues, the RAD Analyst explained that the Committee was going to be referred to another office for further action for the increase in receipts disclosed on their Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The RAD Analyst invited the Committee to provide any additional information they may have on this issue (Attachment 4).

On July 31, 2017 the Committee filed an Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The report disclosed no change in receipts from the prior amendment (Image 201707319069909262).

### **Failure to Provide Supporting Schedules (Failure to File 48-Hour Reports)**

CITIZENS UNITED SUPER PAC LLC ("the Committee") failed to file two (2) 48-Hour Reports totaling \$76,664.32 to support eighty-three (83) independent expenditures disclosed on the 2016 April Quarterly Report made up to and including the 20th day before the 2016 General Election (Attachment 3).

On April 15, 2016, the Committee filed the 2016 April Quarterly Report covering the period from January 1, 2016 through March 31, 2016, which included a Schedule E (Itemized Independent Expenditures) disclosing thirty-six (36) independent expenditures totaling \$229,862.44 made in opposition to one (1) federal candidate (Images 201604159012562787-804).

On April 29, 2016, the Committee filed two (2) Amended 2016 April Quarterly Reports. Both reports included a Schedule E disclosing two hundred sixty four (264) independent expenditures totaling \$544,187.73 made in opposition of one (1) federal candidate. The Committee failed to file two (2) 48-Hour Reports to support eighty-eight (88) independent expenditures totaling \$101,660.31 for the 2016 General Election (Images 201604299015366694-825 and 201604299015366945-7076).

On August 18, 2016, a Request for Additional Information (RAI) was sent to the Committee referencing the Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report, received April 29, 2016. Among other issues, the RF AI noted that the Committee may have failed to file one or more of the required 48-Hour Reports regarding independent expenditures. A chart was included with the RF AI identifying the eighty-eight (88) independent expenditures, totaling \$101,660.31, for which 48-Hour Reports had not been filed (Image 201608180300057171).

On September 22, 2016, the Committee filed an Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The amended report disclosed modifications to several dissemination dates (Image 201609229032100482-613).

Subsequently, on the same day, the Committee filed a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission ("FEC Form 99") which provided additional information related to the RF AI sent on the Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The FEC Form 99 stated, in part:

"Additionally for Item 6, the Committee acknowledges that it failed to file 48 hour reports in connection with three separate direct mail communications. Two of the direct mail communications were mailed on

or about February 22, 2016 and the third direct mail communication was mailed on or about March 9, 2016. The failure occurred because the direct mail firm that was responsible for the mailing failed to follow established protocol requiring that firm to advise the committee in advance of each mailing of date of the mailing and estimated costs of the mailing. Consequently, the committee did not learn that the three mailings had been publicly disseminated until it reviewed the financial data in connection with the preparation of its quarterly report. The direct mail firm has acknowledged to the committee that it erred in failing to follow the established protocol and has given the committee assurances that the error will not be repeated. The report itself identifies each of the independent expenditures for which a 48 hour report was not filed. The committee has also amended its report to correct clerical errors involving the dates of dissemination for certain items listed in the RFAI" (Image 201609229032100362).

On October 18, 2016, the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) Analyst called Lauren Catts, the Committee's Treasurer, and informed her that several items from the RFAI sent on the Committee's Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report had not been responded to adequately and the issues were on the verge of being sent to another office for potential further action by the Commission. Ms. Catts explained she was simply the signatory for the Committee, and the filings were handled by their attorney, Michael Boos. Ms. Catts transferred the RAD Analyst to Mr. Boos (Attachment 4).

Subsequently, on the same day, the RAD Analyst was transferred to Michael Boos, the Committee's designated agent and attorney. The RAD Analyst explained the Committee had been sent a RF AI on their Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report, received April 29, 2016. While noting the Committee had responded to the RFAI, the RAD Analyst explained, among other things, that the Committee's explanation for their apparent failure to file 48-Hour Reports was inadequate. The RAD Analyst directed Mr. Boos' attention to the chart at the end of the RFAI which listed every independent expenditure believed to be missing a required 48-Hour Report. The RAD Analyst invited the Committee to file additional information regarding this issue, and again explained the apparent violation could be referred on to another office for further action (Attachment 4).

On October 25, 2016, the Committee filed an Amended 2016 April Quarterly Report. The amended report disclosed two hundred thirty (230) independent expenditures totaling \$332,375.29 made in opposition to one (1) federal candidate. The amended report disclosed modifications to several dissemination dates. In addition, the Committee clarified in the purpose field that several independent expenditures referenced in the RFAI were disclosed as estimates on previously filed 48-Hour Reports. Despite the changes, the Committee still failed to file two (2) 48-Hour Reports to disclose eighty-three (83) independent expenditures totaling \$76,664.32 (Image 201610259034569139- 254).
