RESOLUTION TERMS: Certify that a representative of the Committee participates
in an FEC conference, webinar, or other program
developed in consultation with the FEC's Information
Division; and pay a civil penalty of \$2,100.

Attached for your review is a signed negotiated ADR Settlement Agreement pertaining to ADR 848 (RR 16L-21). The Commission voted to transfer this matter from the Office of General Counsel to the ADR Office on October 24, 2017.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Respondents for failure to timely file one (1) 48-Hour Report totaling \$41,745.17 to support fifty (50) independent expenditures disclosed on the 2015 Year-End Report.

The Committee contends this was an inadvertent omission. The Committee further indicates that the amount at issue represents a very small portion of its activity, totaling only 0.05% of the \$86,817,478.31 it spent on independent expenditures during the 2016 election cycle.
