The Federal Election Commission (FEC or Commission) referred a compliance issue to the FEC's Alternative Dispute Resolution Office (ADR Office) for processing. The referral by the Audit Division was based on a review of reports filed by Nevada Republican Central Committee which reflect a possible failure to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. The Commission received no reply from Respondents.

If Respondents are interested in having this referral resolved through ADR, you must affirmatively respond **no later than May 18, 2018**, by filing an executed Commitment to Participate in ADR. Another copy of this document is enclosed for your convenience. You may return this document by e-mail.

A lack of response will be considered a disinterest in proceeding in ADR and will result in the matter regarding your Committee being forwarded to the FEC's Office of General Counsel.
