Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division referred RAD 18L-20 for processing on June 11, 2018, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 874. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We expect initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 874 within five (5) business days. Please contact Krista Roche if you have any questions or concerns before then.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred Restore American Freedom and Liberty and Alexander Hornaday, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its Amended 2016 October Quarterly Report, filed on October 16, 2016. On January 24, 2018, the Committee filed an Amended 2016 October Quarterly Report including \$64,958.07 in additional disbursements.

The Committee filed a Miscellaneous Electronic Submission (Form 99) on April 3, 2018, indicating that the Respondent "did not have access to the statements for one of the committee's bank accounts" and "relied on what turned out to be incomplete invoicing from vendors" when filing reports in 2016. The Respondent indicates that the anomaly was discovered in 2017 after he "got full access to the banking records." In addition, the Committee contends that "in the latter half of 2017 the committee conducted an internal audit, and amended the filings accordingly."
