RESOLUTION TERMS: work with Commission
staff to terminate political committee status and reporting
obligations.

Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 892 (RAD 18L-33). The ADR Office received this referral on November 5, 2018.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred The Congressman Joe Barton Committee and Kristin Barton, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to timely refund or redesignate 2018 General Election contributions totaling \$49,062.50 within the permissible timeframe after the candidate withdrew from the 2018 Texas Primary Election. All contributions have been refunded, albeit untimely.

In a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) filed on August 3, 2018, the Respondents stated that they were unaware of the requirement to return contributions and that funds were returned upon notification from RAD. In addition, Respondents contend that former Congressman Barton does not plan to
