
**CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME
TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT**

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission granting an extension of time to August 16, 2018, to respond to the Interim Audit Report pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30111(b) and Commission Directive 70, Marsha Blackburn for Congress, Inc., hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action the Commission might institute pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of twenty-nine (29) days.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of twenty-nine (29) calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of Marsha Blackburn for Congress, Inc.
