Treasurer, Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division referred RAD 19L-03 for processing on March 4, 2019, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 904. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We expect initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 904 within five (5) business days. Please contact Krista Roche if you have any questions or concerns before then.

Summary of Case: RAD referred Legislative Majority PAC and Eleanor Collinson, Treasurer (Respondents for the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2017 Mid-Year Report, filed July 31, 2017. On May 18, 2018, the Committee filed an Amended 2017 Mid-Year Report including \$363,767.47 in additional receipts and \$348,033.94 in additional disbursements.

The Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) on September 19, 2018 stating that it hired a compliance firm to perform a comprehensive review of past filings dating back to 2016. The Committee states that based on the results of this review it "filed the necessary amendments to correct the public record." The Committee later filed an additional Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) on January 25, 2019 further clarifying that the Committee's reconciliation process had "uncovered that certain debts reported after the 2016 General Election were based on estimates that were later corrected or were otherwise misreported."
