The Reports Analysis Division referred RAD 19L-15 for processing on July 2, 2019, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 919. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We expect initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 919 within five (5) business days. Please contact Krista Roche if you have any questions or concerns before then.

**Summary of Case:** RAD referred LIUNA Minnesota & North Dakota/Laborers' District Council of Minnesota & North Dakota and Tim Mackey, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all financial activity on its 2018 October Quarterly Report, originally filed on October 15, 2018. On November 19, 2018, the Committee filed an Amended 2018 October Quarterly Report including \$300,037.07 in additional receipts and \$180,059.47 in additional disbursements.

The Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) on November 19, 2018, stating that the failure to disclose all receipts and disbursements on the original report was due to an inadvertent administrative error. Further, the Committee noted that the original report "failed to include any receipts and only included the 'federal' expenditures," and stated that the amended report "provided all receipts along with all disbursements which included the 'state' expenditures."
