SUBJECT: ADR 920 Million More Voters, Sponsored by the California Labor Federation, AFL-CIO and Art Pulaski, Treasurer, Informational Memo on Assignment

The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred RAD 19L-16 for processing on July 9, 2019, and the ADR Office designated the referral ADR 920. We include a summary and discussion of the referral for your information. We expect initiating communication with Respondents in ADR 920 within five (5) business days. Summary of Case: RAD referred Million More Voters, Sponsored by the California Labor Federation, AFL-CIO and Art Pulaski, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose newly incurred debts on its 2018 October Quarterly Report, originally filed on October 15, 2018. On December 17, 2018, the Committee filed an Amended 2018 October Quarterly Report including \$196,452.00 in newly incurred debts that were not disclosed on the original report.

The Committee filed a Form 99 (Miscellaneous Electronic Submission) on May 20, 2019, stating that the previously undisclosed debts did not relate to the Committee's federal activities. Respondents further state that an amended report was filed to disclose the activity once the Committee became aware of the invoices.
