RESOLUTION TERMS: Pay a civil penalty of \$5,450 and work with Commission
staff to terminate political committee status and reporting
obligations.

Attached for your review is a signed Negotiated Settlement pertaining to ADR 920 (RAD 19L-16). The ADR Office received this referral on July 9, 2019.

SUMMARY: The Reports Analysis Division (RAD) referred Million More Voters, Sponsored by the California Labor Federation, AFL-CIO and Art Pulaski, Treasurer (Respondents or the Committee) for failing to disclose all newly incurred debts on its 2018 October Quarterly Report, originally filed on October 15, 2018. On December 17, 2018, the Committee filed an Amended 2018 October Quarterly Report including \$196,452.00 in newly incurred debts that were not disclosed on the original report.

The Committee stated that the additional debts did not relate to the Committee's federal activities and were disclosed on an amended report once the Committee

became aware of the invoices. The Committee further stated that it intends to terminate its political committee status once this matter has been resolved.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

2. Approve the appropriate letters.
3. Close the file on this matter.
